Westview High School dance director Shannon Parker fielded many questions from prospective dancers after the shows.

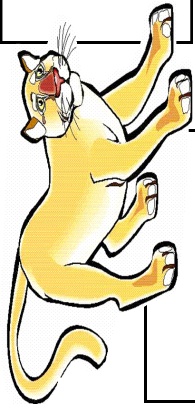
We're joining the Labels for Education program...
